***Doodlelearning*** -the four apps create every child a personalised learning experience tailored to their needs, helping to boost their confidence and ability.

***Times Table Rock Stars*** -Times Tables Rock Stars is an award-winning maths learning platform where children can practise their times tables like a rock star!

***Numbots*** -is all about every child achieving the “triple win” of understanding, recall and fluency in mental addition and subtraction, so that they move from counting to calculating.

***Picturenews*** - teaches children about current affairs and encourages discussion.

***Boom Reader*** - a digital way for parents and carers to record their child's reading.
